9 NECESSITY, FUNCTION, AND CONFORMITY: KRS 321.235(1)(b) requires the board to  
10 promulgate administrative regulations to implement **and enforce** KRS Chapter 321. KRS  
11 321.235(2)(b)2. **authorizes[provides]** the board [**authority**] to promulgate administrative  
12 regulations to establish conditions for applications and permitting of allied animal health  
13 professional (AAHP) facilities. This administrative regulation establishes requirements for AAHP  
14 facility registration renewal and reinstatement applications.

15 Section 1. Renewal Notices and Timeliness of Renewal Applications.

16 (1) The board shall, not later than **August 31[July 1]** of each odd-numbered year, email or mail to  
17 each registered AAHP facility a biennial renewal notice.

18 (2) The renewal application shall be completed by the AAHP manager or registered responsible  
19 party and returned to the board, including all required attachments and, if required by the board,  
20 proof of course completion for the required continuing education.

21 (3) Timely receipt of renewal application.

1 (a) Renewals bearing a postmark, or, if an online renewal, a timestamp, of **not later than**  
2 September 30 of every odd **numbered** year **beginning in 2027 and each odd numbered year**  
3 **thereafter [or earlier]** shall be considered received on time.

4 (b) Renewals bearing a postmark, or, if an online renewal, a timestamp, on or after October 1 of  
5 every odd **numbered** year shall be considered late and shall cause the registration status to be  
6 changed to expired. There shall be no grace period for registered facility renewal.

7 (4) **Renewal fee.**

8 **(a) The renewal fee shall be paid pursuant to 201 KAR 16:517; and**

9 **(b) The renewal fee shall be attached to the completed renewal form when it is returned to**  
10 **the board or paid online with the completion of the online renewal form.**~~Applicants for~~  
11 ~~renewal that miss the deadline will be required to complete a reinstatement application in~~  
12 ~~accordance with Section 4 of this administrative regulation.]~~

13 Section 2. Renewal Application.

14 (1) The renewal application shall be completed by the registered responsible party or AAHP  
15 manager and returned to the board, including all required attachments.

16 (2) A renewal application to the board for an AAHP facility registration shall include the following  
17 components:

18 (a) A completed application on the Renewal Application for Registered AAHP Facilities form or  
19 online equivalent form, including all required attachments and fees **pursuant to 201 KAR 16:517;**

20 (b) Identification of any changes to the registered responsible party;

21 (c) Identification of the AAHP manager;

22 (d) A copy of the business registration from the Kentucky Secretary of State;

23 (e) Identification of the type of AAHP facility from one **(1)** or more in a list provided by the board;

- 1 (f) Identification of the species served by the facility from one (1) or more in a list provided by the  
2 board;
- 3 (g) Identification of the patient services offered at the AAHP[veterinary] facility from one (1) or  
4 more in a list provided by the board;
- 5 (h) A complete list of AAHP permittees working at the facility;
- 6 (i) A complete list of all mobile units affiliated with the AAHP facility;
- 7 (j) Disclosure of afterhours care arrangements;
- 8 (k) For fixed facilities, county of location and counties served;
- 9 (l) For mobile units, a list of the counties served by the mobile unit;
- 10 (m) Hours of facility operation; and
- 11 (n) A copy of any court documents, final orders, settlement agreements, or other  
12 information[documents] requested by the board in support of the application.

13 (3) A change in fifty (50) percent or more of ownership or of the registered responsible parties  
14 shall be cause for the board to deny an AAHP facility renewal and require a new AAHP facility  
15 application.

16 Section 3. Failure to Renew.

17 (1) Applicants for renewal that miss the AAHP facility registration renewal deadline shall  
18 immediately cease operations offering AAHP services.

19 (2) If the registered responsible party desires to continue offering AAHP services on the  
20 premises or from a mobile unit, they shall submit a complete reinstatement application in  
21 accordance with Section 4 of this administrative regulation. [Renewal fee.

22 ~~(1) The renewal fee shall be paid in accordance with 201 KAR 16:517; and~~

~~(2) The renewal fee shall be attached to the completed renewal form when it is returned to the board or paid online with the completion of the online renewal form.~~

Section 4. Reinstatement. A registered responsible party or AAHP manager may apply for reinstatement of an expired AAHP facility registration if not more than five (5) years have elapsed since the last date of registration expiration pursuant to KRS 321.203. Applications to the board for reinstatement of a AAHP facility registration shall include the following components:

(1) A completed application on a Reinstatement Application for Registered AAHP Facilities form or online equivalent form, including the following components and all required attachments and fees pursuant to 201 KAR 16:517;

(2) Identification of any changes to the registered responsible party;

(3) Identification of the AAHP manager;

(4) A copy of the business registration from the Kentucky Secretary of State;

(5) Identification of the type of AAHP facility from one (1) or more in a list provided by the board;

(6) Identification of the type of AAHP facility from one (1) or more in a list provided by the board;

(7) Identification of the species served by the facility from one (1) or more in a list provided by the board;

(8) Identification of the patient services offered at the AAHP[~~veterinary~~] facility from one (1) or more in a list provided by the board;

(9) A complete list of AAHP permittees working at the facility;

(10) A complete list of all mobile units affiliated with the AAHP facility;

(11) Disclosure of afterhours care arrangements;

(12) For fixed facilities, county of location and counties served;

(13) For mobile units, a list of the counties served by the mobile unit;

1 (14) Hours of facility operation; and  
2 (15) A copy of any court documents, final orders, settlement agreements, or other  
3 **information[documents]** requested by the board in support of the application.

4 Section 5. Background Checks. Pursuant to KRS 321.189, the board may:

5 (1) Conduct a national or jurisdictional level background check on each AAHP manager applicant  
6 for AAHP facility registration. The check shall be processed by a board approved background  
7 check provider and may include a copy of the applicant's fingerprints captured at a board-approved  
8 location;

9 (2) Reject background checks that do not have an official seal or watermark, or that are more than  
10 ninety (90) days old; and

11 (3) Impose additional requirements as a condition of registration or deny the AAHP facility  
12 application or the designated **AAHP[veterinarian]** manager following the board's review of  
13 findings from a background check.

This administrative regulation establishes requirements for allied animal health professional (AAHP) facility registration renewal and reinstatement applications.

(b) The necessity of this administrative regulation:

This new administrative regulation is necessary to establish clear requirements for renewal and reinstatement applications for AAHP facility registrations.

(c) How this administrative regulation conforms to the content of the authorizing statutes:

KRS 321.235(1)(b) requires the board to promulgate administrative regulations to implement KRS Chapter 321. KRS 321.235(2)(b)2. provides the board authority to promulgate administrative regulations to establish conditions for applications and permitting of AAHP facilities.

(d) How this administrative regulation currently assists or will assist in the effective administration of the statutes:

This new administrative regulation will assist in effective administration by clearly expressing the application requirements approved by the board for the renewal and reinstatement of AAHP facility registrations.

No costs are associated with compliance, as this is a prerequisite for renewal and reinstatement applications.

Administrative ease of clear communications of the fees associated with registration.

administrative regulation:

(a) Initially:

The KBVE expects costs for all board operations to be approximately \$759,700 annually in the near term.

(b) On a continuing basis:

The KBVE expects costs for all board operations to be approximately \$900,000 annually in future bienniums as new programming is brought online, per the mandates in the modernized Kentucky Veterinary Medicine Practice Act, KRS Chapter 321.

(6) What is the source of the funding to be used for the implementation and enforcement of this administrative regulation:

KBVE does not receive any general funds. All funds for the agency come from licensing fees, service fees, and administrative fines.

(7) Provide an assessment of whether an increase in fees or funding will be necessary to implement this administrative regulation, if new, or by the change if it is an amendment:

There is no anticipation of an increase in fees to implement this administrative regulation, as the KBVE is already running an administrative program to process applications and an inspection program to ensure compliance.

This regulation does not establish or increase any fees, directly or indirectly.

**Cost Savings:** There will be no cost savings; this administrative regulation simply codifies the requirements, making them easily accessible for regulated entities.

Staff time and database management will be required for record keeping. Costs will be minimal.

The requirement for CE is sometimes used as a remedial measure in licensee discipline, and therefore this language is appropriate. In response to these comments, the Board did not make any changes to the proposed administrative regulation.

(a) Comment: Agency – Following review, the agency notes changes are necessary to in Sections 1 and 3 related to clarification on renewal requirements, deadlines, and actions following failure to renew.
